Author (s) of the chapter: Give the last name and initials (e. g. Watson, J. D.) of up to 20 authors with the last name preceded by an ampersand (&). For 21 or more authors include the first 19 names followed by an ellipsis (...) and add the last author's name.

Chapter in an edited book, reprinted from another book Do not create references for chapters of authored books. Instead, write a reference for the whole authored book and cite the chapter in the text if desired.

Parenthetical citation of a chapter of an authored book:

Edited Book Chapter References - APA Style

The edition is added by adding the number and the abbreviation for edition, which is "ed."

Add a period and comma after ed. Then, add the page numbers of the chapter, which are preceded by the abbreviation for pages, which is "pp." Place in

Book Chapter & Ebook Chapter - Citation Help for APA, 7th ...

The 7th edition of APA does not differentiate between the format of the books, print or electronic. Cite both the same way. If you have an open-access eBook, you may provide the URL at the

Basic book citation format The APA in-text citation for a book includes the author's last name, the year, and (if relevant) a page number. In the reference list, start with the author's last

An APA reference page listing requires different information and formatting depending on whether the entire book is written by one author (or authors) or is an edited anthology of chapters by different

APA Book Format

Textbooks usually consist of chapters written by many authors. So, the name that appears on the binding is usually that of the editor. In APA style, list the editor's last name first, followed by his initials, and in parentheses, list "Ed" followed by a period; use "Eds" for
