Compression: ventilation ratio- The compression: ventilation ratio for 1 rescuer CPR in infants is 30:2, the same as for single rescuer CPR in adults and children. When two rescuers are present, the compression: ventilation ratio drops to 15:2, the same as in children.

Compression ventilation is performed by lifting the victim's chin with two fingers and breathing into their mouth until you see their chest rise. Release all the pressure during the relaxation phase of compression, and the release should last longer in time than the downward compression. There should be 120 movements that occur each minute – 30 breaths and 90 compressions, with 3 compressions for each breath(Hemway, Christman, & Perlman, 2013). Finger compressions (Panel B) are acceptable, but less effective, generally.
