The frog uses the vomerine teeth to stab and secure its prey, while its maxillary teeth are used to crush the food before swallowing. Trace the path of food through the digestive tract. The frog catches its food using its tongue. The food is pulled into the mouth, where it is crushed into smaller bits by the maxillary teeth and swallowed by the pharynx.

Student Guide to the Frog Dissection Dissection Instructions. 1. Place the frog in the dissecting pan ventral side up. 2. Use scissors to lift the abdominal muscles away from the body cavity. Cut along the midline of the body to the forelimbs. 3. Make transverse (horizontal) cuts near the arms and legs. 4. Lift the flaps of the body wall and pin back.
