### How to study textbooks (Tips and Strategy)

Effectively reading your textbook is like creating a drawing. The first step we take should be getting an overview of what we are about to read. This is equivalent to an artist drawing an outline. In the same way an outline sets up the boundaries of a drawing, a mental overview sets up the boundaries of what we are about to learn.

### How to Effectively & Efficiently Read or Study A Textbook ...

Select a small chunk (a few paragraphs at most) of your textbook. It's important to determine a firm stopping point so that you focus on just that one chunk of information. 2. Read the section carefully, jotting down what you feel are the key points and important information to remember.

Take well organized notes on the backside of your corresponding class lecture notes. This way your lecture notes and textbook notes for the same topic will be easy to access and review in preparation for the test.
