This is in contrast to autofocus, where your camera tells the lens where to focus (based on the camera's analysis of the scene, as well as some choices from the photographer).

Manual Focus When working at high magnifications, you cannot rely on the autofocus of your lens. You need pinpoint accuracy to focus for macro shots. Macro lenses don't have the best autofocusing capabilities, especially at high magnifications.

### **How to Focus for Tack Sharp Macro Photography | Focus Macro**

In manual focus, you physically manipulate the DSLR camera lens to focus on the image. To focus an image in manual mode, using your left hand (which is resting under the camera lens), pinch the focus ring on the lens and turn slightly to the left or right until the image is in focus. Manual focus must be done through the viewfinder.
