### PATIENT RATED WRIST EVALUATION

PRWE is the Patient-Rated Wrist Evaluation.The PRWE is a 15-item questionnaire designed to measure wrist pain and disability in activities of daily living. Developed in 1998 for clinical assessment and is used for specific wrist problems.It is one of the reliable upper extremity outcome instrument.[1]

### Patient Rated Wrist Evaluation - an overview ...

Rate the average amount of pain in your wrist/hand over the past week by circling the number that best describes your pain on a scale from 0-10. A zero (0) means that you did not have any pain and a ten (10) means that the pain is the worst possible (i.e worst you have ever experienced or that you could not do the activity because of pain).

The Patient-Rated Wrist and Hand Evaluation (PRWHE) is a commonly used outcome measure in hand therapy practice aiming to measure such outcomes. ### PRWE - Patient-Rated Wrist Evaluation

The Patient-rated Wrist Evaluation (PRWE) was developed to assess pain in the wrist joint and functional difficulties in activities of daily living resulting from injuries affecting wrist joint area (MacDermid, Turgeon, Richards, Beadle, & Roth, 1998).

Patients with distal radius or scaphoid fractures completed the Patient-Rated Wrist Evaluation (PRWE) on two occasions to determine test-retest reliability. Patients with distal radius fractures (n = 101) completed the PRWE and the SF-36 and were tested with traditional impairment measures at baseline and at two, three, and six months after fracture to determine construct and criterion validity.

### Patient Rating of Wrist Pain and Disability: A Reliable ...

Patient-rated Wrist Evaluation (PRWE) The 15 question PRWE examines wrist pain (n=5) and function (n=10). Scores range from 0 (no pain, full function) to 10 (worst pain or greatest impairment). Pain and function scores are converted to scales of 0-50 and are summed for a total score (0-100 pain and function weighted equally).

### Clinical Research and Patient-Rated Outcome Measures in ...

The Patient-Rated Wrist Evaluation (PRWE) is a patient-reported questionnaire focusing on symptoms and function in wrist pathologies. It consists of 15 questions regarding pain and functional activities of the wrist.

### Validity of the Patient-Rated Wrist Evaluation ...

Measurement properties of the Patient-Rated Wrist and Hand Evaluation: Rasch analysis of responses from a traumatic hand injury population Initial examination of the PRWHE indicates the psychometric properties of consistency, reliability and responsiveness previously tested by classical methods are further supported by Rasch analysis.

### Measurement properties of the Patient-Rated Wrist and Hand ...

The hand and wrist is a series of complex, delicately balanced joints. Function is integral to every act of daily living. It is the most active portion of the upper extremity. A hand and wrist examination done in a structured manner will lead to a correct diagnosis. Remembering that the hand and wrist examination will take in and appreciate that:

The Patient Rated Wrist Evaluation (PRWE) is a region-specific outcome measure that evaluates wrist-related disability. It contains 15 items: five of which evaluate pain (intensity and frequency) and 10 evaluate function (specific activities and usual activities).

### Patient Rated Wrist Evaluation

The patient-rated wrist evaluation (PRWE) was specifically designed to reflect the function of the wrist, while the DASH takes the whole upper extremity into account. Previous studies have found the PRWE to be a valid and responsive questionnaire with regard to wrist function [8, 9].

### Disabilities of the Arm, Shoulder, and Hand Questionnaire ...

The Patient-Rated Wrist Evaluation (PRWE) was developed as a wrist joint specific measure of pain and disability and evidence of sound validity has been accumulated through classical psychometric methods. Rasch analysis (RA) has been endorsed as a newer method for analyzing the clinical measurement properties of self-report outcome measures.
